Termites: Resistant.

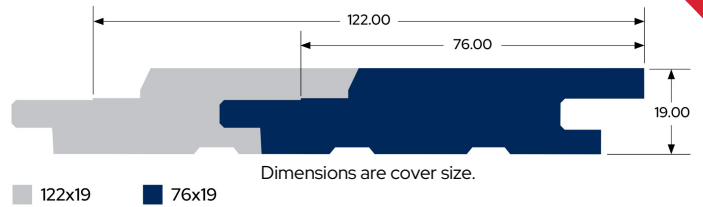

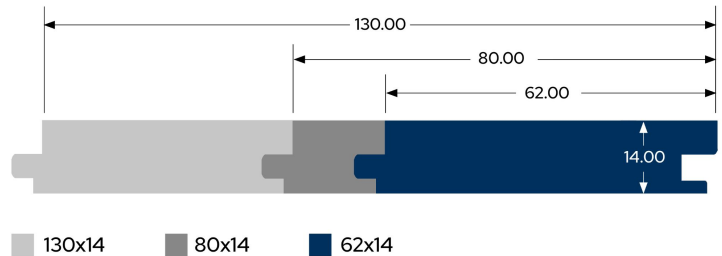

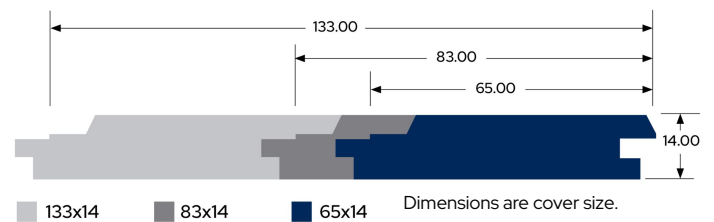
