Hardness: Hard (Janka 8.6).

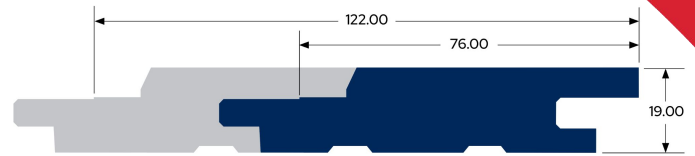

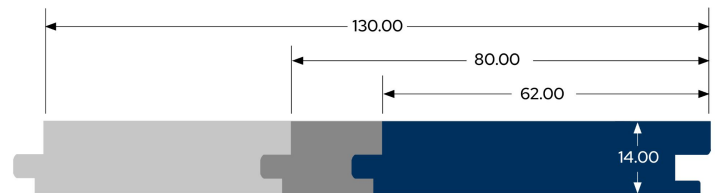

Cladding (Shiplap)



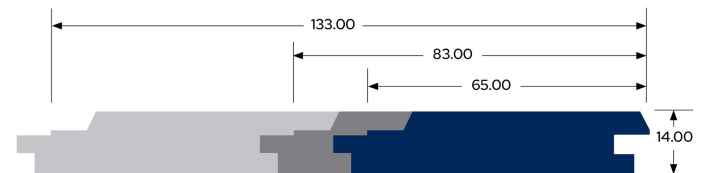

Flooring (Overlay)



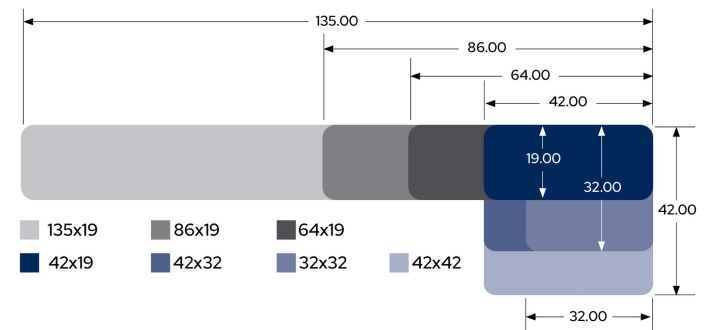
