Tone: Varied, and dark colour palette, typically featuring medium to deep chocolate browns, warm tan, and occasional red-brown hues.

Texture: Dense grain with a soft, mottled effect.

Botanical names: *Corymbia Citriodora*, *Corymbia Henryi*, *Corymbia maculata*.

Durability: Class 1 High (above ground) 40+ years.

Strength Group: High (SD2 Seasoned).

Hardness: Very Hard (Janka 10.1).

Density: 990 – 1180 kg/m³.

BAL Rating AS3959-2009: BAL 29.

Treatment: H2 Internal & H3 External application.

Termites: Resistant.

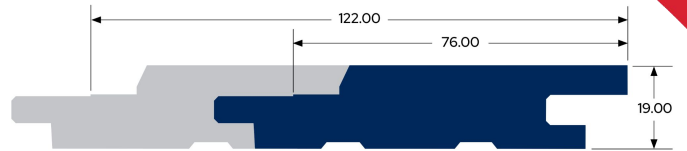

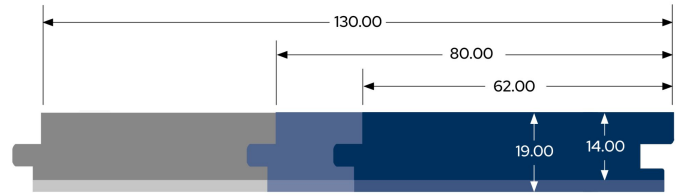

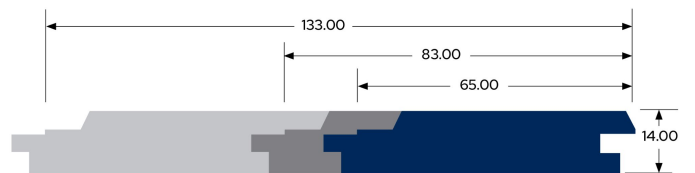

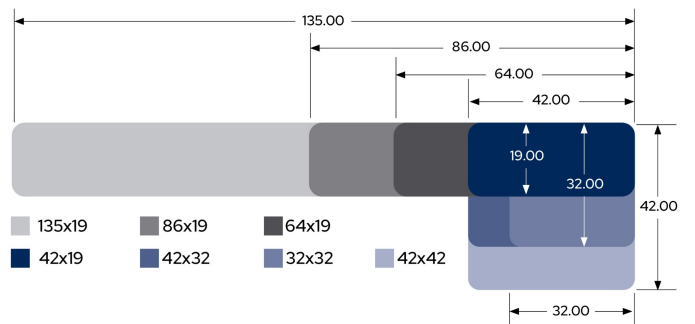
